Accommodation	Students from partner universities are accommodated in university
	dorms. Please note that we don't offer single rooms, only double or
	triple rooms. The rent is about 50 Euro/month/student, depending on
	the dormitory.
	Upon arrival, the students accommodated in the UBB dormitories will
	have to sign a contract with the dormitory administrator (standard
	procedure).
Residence permit	All non EU students will have to apply for a resident permit within the
	first 30 days from their arrival. The resident permit will have to cover
	their entire stay within the Romanian territory.
	Members of the EU, EEA countries and the Swiss Confederation will
	apply for a Certificate of Registration.
	Information about the application procedure will be given to them by
	the CCI staff.
