REQUIREMENTS AND DEADLINES

Rule for undergraduate/postgraduate courses

Undergraduate students are best advised to choose courses at university level, while postgraduate students can choose courses at both undergraduate and postgraduate level.

Rules for courses taught in English

- The enrolment in any specific **course taught in English at Rome Campus cannot be guaranteed and may be subject to availability**. Each course taught in English organized at Rome Campus has a limited access to 20/25 Students. The availability of the course will be assured at the time of the submission of online application and the required documents (including approved learning agreement). Students will be selected based on the date of application and the consistency of the degree path with the content of the degree in which they are enrolled at their home university.
- The English courses that are offered in Palermo do not have any access restrictions and can be guaranteed.**
- Incoming Students can choose courses taught in English only if the home University also provides courses taught in English for LUMSA Students. **Students must request a confirmation to the International Relations Office of their home University.**

Rules for language skills

Erasmus+ incoming Students' language skills must be adequate to the courses they are going to attend. The sending institution, according to inter-institutional agreement, is responsible for providing support to the nominated students so that they have the required language skills at the period of the submission of online application and the documents *beginning of the study period*:

The receipt of the submission has to be sent by email together with the following documents:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Headshot photo in .jpg format; • Valid Identity Card or Passport; • Codice fiscale (Italian tax identification number): to be obtained by applying to the Italian Consular authorities in the Country of residence; • European Health Insurance Card/private insurance; • Italian and/or English language certificate, depending on the selected language of courses; • Learning Agreement in PDF format <u>only in case the partner University is not active on EWP</u>; • Relevant medical certifications in case of disabilities or special needs. <p>Application will be approved and an acceptance letter can be sent to the student and the home university only if all the required documents are submitted in time.</p> <p>*If the student faces difficulty obtaining the Italian tax code (Codice Fiscale) from the Italian consulate, the tax code can be submitted after arrival in Rome.</p> <p>The students are required to check their email.
