"Continuity and change in Swedish Higher Education"

Teaching in Swedish universities is guided by the principle of "freedom with responsibility." Students are encouraged to engage in independent and group learning, emphasizing teamwork, decision-making, time management, and interpersonal skills. International students enrich the learning environment by bringing diverse skills, preparing students for a global career with cross-cultural teamwork.

However, recent challenges like the pandemic, AI development, and geopolitical conflicts have affected higher education. In her talk, Professor Syssner will discuss these issues, based on her experiences as a university teacher and university leader, along with relevant studies.

Josefina Syssner is professor of human geography working at the Center for Local Government Studies at Linköping university, Sweden. Her research focuses on local policy, planning, and development in the Nordic countries – primarily in sparsely populated areas with long distances, shrinking population bases, and other spatial disadvantages.
