<b>Transcript</b> upon completion of exchange stay	SDU will issue a digital transcript once the examinations have been finalized.  Students will receive an email in their SDU e-mail account with information on how to access their Digital Diploma Mailbox.  The transcripts are fully secured with an embedded verification link that allows the recipient of the diploma to view the document directly from the SDU server in addition to a downloaded version.
